

## **Statistics**



- Since 1980, only three drugs have been approved for use in treating children with cancer. Two, Teniposide (1980) and Clofarabine (2004) are used to treat all childhood cancers. The third drug, Unituxin (Dinutuximab) was approved in 2015 for treating high-risk Neuroblastoma. Fewer than eight total drugs, consisting of the above referenced drugs combined with five other drugs that are approved for adults have been developed for children with cancer—compared to the 100+drugs that have been developed specifically for adulthood cancer. Most childhood cancer treatments have been virtually unchanged since the 1970s.
- In addition to unchanged treatments, a childhood cancer diagnosis is a lifetime diagnosis. Children that develop cancer are five times more likely to develop a secondary cancer later in life.
- Children that receive cancer treatments also face infertility, heart disease, loss of eye sight, cataracts, and other major health issues due to the harsh side effects of cancer treating drugs and overuse of steroids during treatments.
